

Official Notice: 13 December 1862 A Call to Arms!

It is the duty of all available men and women of the Union Scatacook Territory to join in a call to arms at this time of dire need! Three Union soldiers, sent to the Confederate states as spies, succeeded in joining a small militia of Virginia soldiers under the command of Lieutenant General Jubal Early.

After two weeks of encampment near the shores of the Potomac, the soldiers learned of a daring Confederate plot to slip into the Union Northeast quietly and lightly armed. Once there the soldiers hope to spread lies of Union motives and recruit enough soldiers to disrupt the flow of soldiers to the south and perhaps mount an uprising of resistance against the Union!

Only one of the three brave soldiers that joined Early's militia returned. All three were captured and held as spies after being overheard discussing plans to slip away from the militia and return to the Union, but only one managed to escape and relay his message. From wounds incurred during his escape, this soldier died too, three days later.

The inevitable skirmish will likely unfold on the open fields of the Hoyt Farm in Redding, Connecticut on 3 November of the coming year. Arrive a day early to prepare a camp nearby. Expect updated notices as information becomes available. Defend your land!
