WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW ...

Fill up your water bags and don your fedora — Cub Scouts will explore the sands at the **2006 Egyptian Day Camp!** Boys will brave the ScorpionKing's Obstacle Challenge, decode hieroglyphics, search for treasure in King Tut's pyramid and visit the Luxor Bazaar, and learn to shoot like Ramses' archers, build a pyramid and much more. Earn the Cub Scout Activities Award and learn new cultural traditions all in the spirit of fun.

All forms not already turned in must be brought on the first day. Scouts must bring a bag lunch daily. Day Camp hours are Monday, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Friday 9 a.m. to noon. Camp is open to all Cub Scouts grades 1-5. Parents are encouraged to come Friday afternoon and enjoy a picnic lunch with your son, enjoy a sing along and explore the adventure of camp too.

CHILD SAFETY — Safety is a primary consideration at camp. We have a well supervised program with trained staff. We work closely with the Boy Scouts of America, local, county and state law enforcement agencies, as well as local fire department and conservation officers to ensure the campers safety. All volunteer staff must be registered with the BSA.

QUALIFIED STAFF — Each of our Cub Scout camping programs is administered by a nationally certified camp director and program director along with a health officer (nurse or EMT) and an archery director. All staff members are required to complete special training and are highly qualified.

DENS - Dens are arranged by similar age and rank, as of September 2006. This is done so activities can be presented in an age-appropriate manner. Every effort will be made to keep Scouts from the same pack in the same age/rank group together.

CAMP FEES — Camp fees are \$165 per week. If full payment is received no later than May 1, 2006, you qualify for the Early Bird discount and a camp fee of only \$150. After May 1, 2006 camp will cost \$165. Attend a second week of camp for only \$85. All camp fees must be paid in full by July 1, 2006.

CAMPERSHIPS — Cub Scout Day Camp camperships are available. No Scout should miss camp due to a lack of funds. Campership applications must be submitted by May 31, 2006 and should be accompanied by the camp registration form and a nonrefundable deposit of \$25. Camperships range from partial to full awards, based on need and availability of funds. Applications received after May 31 are not guaranteed consideration. Such consideration depends on availability of funds. You will receive notification if the campership has been accepted or denied.

HEALTH FORM — To meet the state and BSA standards, all Scouts must have a current health form in order to attend (any physical signed by a physician within the past three years will suffice). All health forms must be submitted two weeks before the start of camp.

REFUND POLICY — Each session requires a \$25 non-refundable deposit. Refunds for the balance of the fee are made only for the following:

- ▲ Serious illness, accident or death in the immediate family.
- ▲ Your son is required to attend summer school which conflicts with the camp schedule.
- ▲ Your son moves from Council boundaries prior to camp.

All refund requests must be made in writing and submitted to the Council Resource Center prior to August 31, 2006.

SIGN-UP — To register, send in the registration page with your non-refundable deposit or full payment to the Council Resource Center. No walk-ins will be accepted. Make checks payable to Connecticut Yankee Council, BSA. All registrations must be received 1 week prior to the start of the camp season.
